GLEISS LUTZ ADVISES VKTA AND THE FREE STATE OF SAXONY IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONCLUSION OF A PUBLIC LAW CONTRACT ON THE TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR NUCLEAR FUELS FROM THE FORMER ROSSENDORF RESEARCH REACTOR

A Gleiss Lutz team advised VKTA – Radiation Protection, Analytics & Disposal Rossendorf e.V. (VKTA) and the Free State of Saxony in connection with the conclusion of a public law contract for the transfer of 18 CASTOR® MTR2 casks containing nuclear fuels from the former GDR Dresden-Rosendorf research reactor. With this contract, the Federal Republic is assuming responsibility for these nuclear fuels.

VKTA - financed by the Free State of Saxony - is realising the dismantling of the old nuclear facilities at the former GDR Dresden-Rosendorf research site. This includes the safe disposal of nuclear materials and radioactive waste as well as long-term radiation protection at the site. VKTA also offers its services to external partners in possession of nuclear waste for demanding tasks and projects in nuclear or industry-related fields of activity.
