He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (FCI Arb) and a member of the American Law Institute (ALI) and the SIAC Users Council. Since 2019, he is a Vice President of the CAAI Court of Arbitration. Since 2021 he is a member of the International Arbitration Committee (IAC) at the Korean Commercial Arbitration Board (KCAB, South Korea).
